# Protecting our Waters

Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council addressed a number of issues in 2014. Some of the threats facing our watersheds were invasive species, stormwater runoff, and the accumulation of pharmacueticals and plastic microbeads in our waters.

Over the past year, the Watershed Council has been highly engaged in oil and gas issues. We continued to champion for stronger regulations regarding the safety of our water, including a technique used during natural gas and oil development known as hydraulic fracturing, or fracking, and significant research on the Line 5 pipeline that crosses the Straits of Mackinac and traverses through our service area.

These battles to protect our waters are not won single-handedly. We know that the future of our waters lies collectively in our hands.





#### **Line 5 Pipeline**

Line 5, owned and operated by Enbridge Energy Partners, is located in the Straits of Mackinac and traverses through Northern Michigan, crossing under and near many sensitive water resources. The Watershed Council has devoted significant time to research, public education and outreach, pipeline incident prevention, emergency preparedness, and advocacy.

In 2014, the Watershed Council conducted pipeline sensitivity mapping to identify areas along the pipeline route that are most at risk in the event of a spill. We also hosted a Northern Michigan Pipeline Symposium designed to raise awareness and understanding about pipeline issues and pipeline safety in Northern Michigan. The symposium involved presentations on pipeline safety and Enbridge's Line 5, as well as a panel question and answer session.

Additionally, we participated in emergency response preparedness efforts, which involved four Watershed Council staff who joined over 200 people in Indian River for a simulated pipeline exercise. We participated as staff in the Emergency Operations Center, which served as a central location for officials to coordinate response efforts, make decisions, and gather and disseminate information. We also took part in a wildlife rescue training.

The Watershed Council also served on the Local Emergency Planning Committee for Emmet County to help ensure our water resources are adequately considered and protected in the event of an emergency.

#### **Wetland Protection**

For over four decades, advances in science have shown that protection of Great Lakes coastal wetlands is essential to the health of the Great Lakes. That is why we could not sit idly by and watch the destruction of Great Lakes coastal wetlands within our service area.

Since 2009, the Watershed Council had been working to protect 35 acres of Great Lakes coastal wetlands outside of the City of Cheboygan, along Duncan Bay. The original proposal was to build a luxury motorcoach RV park, depositing over 10,000 cubic yards of fill, and impacting nearly four wetland acres.

The initial permit was denied by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), but that decision was reversed during an appeal process for a modified proposal. The Watershed Council formally contested the MDEQ decision.

A shoreline survey of the parcel was conducted by the Watershed Council in 2013 while developing a Watershed Management Plan for Duncan and Grass Bays. This particular parcel included both submergent and emergent marsh and a variety of shade intolerant successional woodlands mix, along with shrub and herbaceous openings. This property creates, not only desirable habitat for wetland and upland birds, but also a significant greenbelt. Shoreline greenbelts reduce erosion by stabilizing the soil, slowing runoff, and filtering nutrients, sediments, and other pollution - all things that our Great Lakes need in times of shifting climates.

After five years of dispute, we convinced the applicant to engage with the Little Traverse Conservancy, who then purchased the land in the fall of 2014. Now this wetland, with 750 feet along Lake Huron, is protected.



#### **Effective Restoration Advocacy**

In 2014, Congressman Benishek joined Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council and partners for a tour of Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) projects. The group made visits to a stream restoration project on Lower Tannery Creek and the North Central Michigan College (NCMC) Stormwater Wetland. Project partners that assisted with the tour included staff from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Northwest Design Group Consulting Engineers, Top of Michigan Trails Council, and North Central Michigan College.

Our staff also led a site visit tour for Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Director, Dan Wyant, and his staff to visit a number of projects in Emmet County that are designed to protect water resources. Sites included a new clearspan bridge over Tannery Creek at the Little Traverse Wheelway and a natural shoreline demonstration site that was installed as part of the Michigan Natural Shoreline Partnership's Certified Natural Shoreline Professional training at Camp Pet-O-Se-Ga.



Engaging policy makers through site visits allows us to connect them to our water resources in a way that they will remember when it's time to make important decisions that

will impact the future of Michigan's most valuable natural resource - water.

Additionally, our Policy and Advocay team continues to be fully engaged locally and at the state and federal levels. We ensure that Michigan's water resources have a voice among those that make decisions about their well-being.

# Monitoring our Waters

Monitoring our waters is a perpetual year-long process. Whether we are in the field, in the lab, compiling data, or writing reports, there is always something to do.

Our monitoing efforts rely heavily on the assistance of trained volunteers from the community that share our passion for protecting our water resources. Keeping a watchful eye on the health of our waters each year is an enormous job and we couldn't do it without their help.



Our Monitoring Report includes the findings from our Volunteer Lake and Stream Monitoring programs, as well as our Comprehensive Water Quality Monitoring program.

Our Comprehensive Water Quality Monitoring (CWQM) database now includes over 8,000 water quality measurements! These data are used regularly by the Watershed Council to assess lake and stream health, develop watershed management plans, evaluate the success of restoration projects, and much more. It is not only a resource for us, but the data are also utilized for numerous organizations, agencies, local governments, and researchers in their efforts to protect the lakes and streams we cherish in Northern Michigan.




#### **Coastal Tributary Monitoring**

Northern Michigan is blessed with legendary streams. Rivers like the Jordan and Boyne have left their marks in history and continue to shape our communities. Many of our beloved streams have membership-based groups whose sole purpose is to carry out programs that protect them. On the other hand, there are lesser known streams that rarely receive attention, being forever in the shadow of their larger, more popular, counterparts. Thanks to support from the Joyce Foundation, they were front and center during our 2014 field season as part of a Coastal Tributary Study.

The purpose of the tributary study was to better understand the impacts of small coastal tributaries on the water quality of Lake Michigan. These small coastal streams generally escape notice and are not typically included in large-scale watershed management plans or monitoring programs. Individually, these small streams are thought to contribute few pollutants and have minimal impacts on the greater Lake Michigan ecosystem. However, we suspected that, colletively, those small coastal tributaries are an important part of the Great Lakes water quality equation.

When all was said and done, we found that our results ranged from comforting to concerning. Although these streams are small in size, when taken in aggregate, the impact of our coastal tributaries is BIG when it comes to the health of our lakes.





#### **Aquatic Invasive Species Monitoring**

With a grant from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality's Clean Water Fund, the Watershed Council monitored the Elk River Chain of Lakes (ERCOL) for five priority invasive species: curly-leaf pondweed, Eurasian watermilfoil, invasive *Phragmites*, purple loosestrife, and quagga mussels. During 2014, monitoring was carried out in the Upper Chain from Beals Lake to Intermediate Lake. Monitoring was accomplished through benthic tows and visual surveys. In addition, detailed vegetation surveys were conducted on Hanley and Intermediate Lakes.

Following 35 benthic tows along the bottom of lakes and interconnecting waterways of the Upper Chain, not a single quagga mussel was found. Only two patches of *Phragmites* were documented after combing over 50 miles of shoreline. Not unexpectedly, purple loosestrife was found throughout the Upper Chain, but generally in small isolated patches. No curly-leaf pondweed was documented and Eurasian watermilfoil was found in small quantities in Six Mile and St. Clair Lakes only.

Monitoring continues in 2015 in the Lower Chain from Lake Bellaire to Elk Lake, with detailed vegetation surveys scheduled for Lake Skegemog and Elk Lake.





#### **Surveying the Waters Edge**


In preparation for developing a new Watershed Management Plan for Burt Lake and the Sturgeon River, Watershed Council staff and interns surveyed multiple lakes and streams during the summer of 2014. Lake shoreline surveys were conducted on Lance, Round, Silver, and Wildwood Lakes to document riparian vegetation (greenbelts), erosion, alterations (e.g., seawalls), and algae, which is a biological indicator of nutrient pollution. Additionally, University of Michigan Biological Station students surveyed Munro Lake.

The banks of the Sturgeon River from Wolverine to Burt Lake, the Maple River from Woodland Road to Brutus Road, and the Crooked River from Crooked Lake to Burt Lake, were surveyed for erosion. In total, 532 lakeshore properties and 26 miles of river were surveyed. Results will be used as a foundational assessment of nonpoint source pollution in the Burt Lake – Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.


#### **Stormwater Monitoring**

Thanks to grants from both the Petoskey-Harbor Springs Area and Charlevoix County Community Foundations, the Watershed Council was able to work with Environmental Canine Services (ECS), a company that utilizes dogs trained specifically to identify human sewage through scent in storm sewer systems. This cost-efficient method provides a rapid screening tool for illicit sewage discharge detection. ECS was joined by Watershed Council staff and Department of Public Works representatives on a tour of Petoskey and Charlevoix, checking dozens of locations to determine if there were any human fecal contamination problems in the municipal stormwater systems. Watershed Council staff later met with both cities to discuss the findings and plan next steps for protecting our waters.

- **1.** Aquatic Vegetation Survey: the Black Lake Association sponsored a comprehensive survey of aquatic vegetation and walleye habitat.
- **Aquatic Vegetation Survey:** the Pickerel-Crooked Lakes Association worked with local units of government to fund a comprehensive survey of Round Lake and the Crooked River.
- Aquatic Vegetation Survey: a comprehensive survey of Hanley Lake was conducted as part of an invasive species monitoring grant from Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ).
- 4. Aquatic Vegetation Survey: a grant was recieved from the MDEQ to conduct invasive species moniotoring on Intermediate Lake in 2014.
- **5. Educational Workshop:** partnered with Paradise Lake Association (PLA) to present a natural shoreline workshop for homeowners.
- **6. Educational Workshop:** partnered with Mullett Area Preservation Society (MAPS) to provide a shoreline landscape design for water quality protection workshop.
- **T** Educational Workshop: hosted an Invasive Species Workshop for local road commissions to bring greater awareness about "roadside invaders" and their management.
- **8. Educational Workshop:** co-instructed a Certified Natural Shoreline Professional training at Camp Pet-O-Se-Ga on Pickerel Lake.
- Greenbelt Installations: as part of our partnership with the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, five greenbelts on Walloon Lake and the Bear River was installed and enhanced with Michigan native plants with support from a Great Lakes Restoration Initiative grant.
- Invasive Species Management: all 70+ miles of Lake Michigan shoreline in Emmet County was surveyed for the third time for invasive *Phragmites*.
- Invasive Species Management: purple loosestrife control efforts were carried out by dispersing *Galerucella* beetles in the Bear River corridor.
- Invasive Species Management: the Upper Elk River Chain of Lakes, from Beals Lake to Intermediate Lake was surveyed for *Phragmites*, purple loosestrife, Eurasian watermilfoil, curly-leaf pondweed, and quagga mussels.
- Priority Parcel Analysis: final products of the priority parcel analysis for the Torch Lake Watershed was used to prioritize permanent land protection efforts.
- Road-stream Crossing Inventory: priority road-stream crossings was inventoried in the Maple River Watershed and other Burt Lake direct tributaries.
- **Road-stream Crossing Inventory:** priority road-stream crossings was inventoried in the Crooked River Watershed.
- **Road-stream Crossing Inventory:** priority road-stream crossings was inventoried in the Sturgeon River Watershed, field work to be conducted by Huron Pines.
- **Shoreline and Streambank Restoration:** we will be putting the final touches on our Tannery Creek restoration project by installing Michigan native plants on the streambanks and in the area immediately around the new timber bridge.



- **Shoreline Survey:** follow-up to the 2012 survey on Crooked and Pickerel Lakes continued with property management assessment letters and informational brochures mailed to riparians.
- Shoreline Survey: questionnaires to assess shoreline property management were planned to go out to riparians as follow-up to Lake Charlevoix survey. This project was not completed.



- Shoreline Survey: Round Lake was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management plan.
- Shoreline Survey: Wildwood and Lance Lakes was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- Shoreline Survey: Silver Lake was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- **Stormwater Management:** we continued working with the City of Cheboygan to assess stormwater impacts to Duncan Bay.
- Stormwater Management: continued installation of rain gardens in Bay View as part of Little Traverse Bay Stormwater Management Initiative.
- Stormwater Management: Pellston was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.

- **Stormwater Management:** Alanson was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- Stormwater Management: the urbanized area around Spring Lake was surveyed to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- **Stormwater Management:** planned to survey Wolverine in 2014 to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- Stormwater Management: planned to survey Vanderbilt in 2014 to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- **Stormwater Management:** planned to survey the northern end of Gaylord in 2014 to gather information for development of the Burt Lake Sturgeon River Watershed Management Plan.
- Stormwater Management: we continued to work with the Village of Boyne Falls to manage stormwater that threatens the Boyne River.
- **Stormwater Management:** dogs from Environmental Canine Services helped us identify any sources of fecal contamination in the City of Petoskey storm sewer system.
- Stormwater Management: dogs from Environmental Canine Services helped us identify sources of fecal contamination in the City of Charlevoix storm sewer system.
- Streambank Erosion Survey: the lower Maple River from Lake Kathleen to Burt Lake was surveyed for streambank erosion.
- **Streambank Erosion Survey:** the Crooked River from Crooked Lake to Burt Lake was surveyed for streambank erosion.
- **Streambank Erosion Survey:** the Sturgeon River from Wolverine to Burt Lake was surveyed for streambank erosion.
- Water Quality Monitoring: we continued monitoring Duncan Bay, Grass Bay, and tributaries for our nonpoint source pollution assessment that will be used for watershed management plan development.
- Water Quality Monitoring: we began our monitoring of the Burt Lake tributaries for our nonpoint source pollution assessment that will be used for watershed management plan development.
- Water Quality Monitoring: this was year 18 of early spring phosphorus monitoring in all five basins of Walloon Lake.
- Water Quality Monitoring: we continued our Lake Charlevoix Tributary Study, monitoring all major tributaries flowing into the lake six times throughout this year.
- Water Quality Monitoring: we continued monitoring four locations on Stover Creek to collect data that will help write the Stover Creek Restoration Plan.
- Water Quality Monitoring: this was the 14th year of monitoring Elk and Skegemog Lakes, which we visit four times throughout the spring, summer, and fall to collect physical and chemical data from both lakes.

# Inspiring Change

Knowledge is power! The more aware people are of the fragility of our waters against the attacks of invasive species, polluted stormwater runoff, pharmaceuticals and plastic microbeads, the more they want to do their part to protect our waters. That is why we spend a great deal of time engaging communities through workshops, events, and targeted campaigns. Our Aquavist Network stay abreast of current issues via email blasts directly from our policy team and our website is continually updated, so the public is armed with a wide variety of current resources.





#### **POD Program**

In 2014, Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council embarked upon a media and education campaign to raise awareness about the Northern Michigan Prescription and Over-the-Counter Drug Drop-off (POD) Program. The POD Program is a multicounty take-back initiative that provides a convenient and environmentally sound way for residents to properly dispose of medications. The Program includes community collection events in Antrim, Charlevoix, Cheboygan, and Emmet Counties, as well as over 20 permanent collection drop boxes at law enforcement agencies throughout Northern Michigan.

The POD Program boasts eight years of implementation. However, there are still many people who are not aware of the program or who are not using this community service. In 2014, the POD Campaign reached out – through magazine and television ads and targeted outreach – to tell everyone to *Put Your Pills in the POD!*

#### **Watershed Awareness**

The Little Traverse Bay Watershed: Stormwater Matters project is the Watershed Council's public outreach campaign to bring awareness to the community about stormwater, how it impacts water resources, and how it can be managed to protect water quality. Stormwater management is a critical piece of watershed protection because stormwater carries nonpoint source pollutants to our lakes, streams, and wetlands.

In 2014, the Watershed Council was awarded a grant from the Michigan Coastal Zone Management Program, Office of the Great Lakes, Department of Environmental Quality and National Oceanic and Atmosphere (NOAA) to expand this education and outreach program. These programs began in 2015.

Additionally, thanks to support from the Petoskey-Harbor Springs Area Community Foundation, Little Traverse Bay Watershed awareness signs were installed on major roads where they intersect with the Watershed boundary. The signs bring watershed awareness to residents and visitors by welcoming them as they enter the Watershed.





#### **Roadside Invaders Workshop**

Many invasive plant species are spread inadvertently by road commissions when road maintenance is performed. Mowing and ditch clearing are particularly detrimental when invasive plants are present. In fact, mowing actually stimulates growth of some invasive species, such as invasive *Phragmites* and Japanese knotweed, thereby worsening the infestation. Given the variety of invasive plants that are prone to populating roadsides and the complexity of treatment options, road commissions are faced with the ongoing challenge of staying informed.

Thanks to a grant from the Petoskey-Harbor Springs Area Community Foundation, Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council hosted an invasive plant species workshop geared toward local county road commissions, conservation districts, and other organizations. The event featured presentations from invasive plant species experts, including: Phyllis Higman, Michigan Natural Features Inventory; Vern Stephens, Designs by Nature; and Heidi Shaffer, Antrim Conservation District. Attendees learned how road commissions play an important role in controlling the spread of invasive plant species.

To assist with field identification, sets of quick reference cards were developed and distributed. The cards feature the top twelve invasive plants that are considered particularly noxious and pose the greatest threat to our natural resources and road infrastructure. Information is given for each species along with photos for easy identification. Recommended



treatment options are also detailed. The laminated cards are connected with a carabineer and will be kept in the road commission vehicles for quick access while in the field and on the road.

# Engaging the Next Generation



Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council is dedicated to providing students with educational opportunties with a focus on watershed protection. Whether we are modeling good stewardship through a river cleanup, exploring the hands-on watershed model, or peering through the microscope at the exciting world of aquatic macroinvertebrates, we know that we are inspiring the next generation of watershed protection stewards.





#### A Family Tradition - Healing the Bear

As the Bear River meanders from Walloon Lake to Petoskey, it accumulates a lot of garbage from road crossings, urban areas, and illegal dumping. On the morning of August 23rd, volunteers of all ages set out to clean up the river and keep it healthy during the "Healing the Bear" Bear River Cleanup. Although faced with slippery banks, fast flows, poison ivy, and two skunks, the volunteers prevailed. Over 7 cubic yards of trash and recyclables were removed from the river.

After hosting the event over the past 15 years we have seen children grow up, move on to college and participate in cleanups elsewhere. It's truly rewarding to know we're making an impact on how they view the health of our waters.

#### **Students Experience Lake Charlevoix**

For over two decades, Tip of the Mitt Waterahed Council has teamed up with the Lake Charlevoix Assocation and a number of volunteers to provide an educational experience like no other. Over 300 middle school students from across Charlevoix County took part in the 21st annual Students Experience Lake Charlevoix. This half-day, hands-on event takes place aboard the Beaver Islander Ferry and introduces students to aquatic invasive species, benthic environments, Secchi disk depths, pH, sources of pollution, and more.

The students learned about watersheds and what they can do to protect them from polluted stormwater runoff and invasive species.

For over three decades, our programs have reached far and wide. Like ripples on a pond, they continue to grow.



Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council had another great year in 2014, both in terms of finance and programming. Despite the fact that we received fewer donations, grants, and investment income this year, our net assets increased slightly. Operating expenses came in right on budget. The market was down substantially this year, but we still made a respectable return on our investments. The Asset Repair and Replacement Fund (ARRF) has grown to \$163,918 from our original investment of \$85,000 in 2011. Cash flow provided sufficient funds for operating all year and it was not necessary to tap into our credit line. Some ongoing grant project activities were delayed until 2015 and that moved expected grant income and expense into 2015 as well.




